

Summary


This technique did not fail in any of the email clients we tested in, serving up either the SVG or the fallback PNG.

Previous testing found that older devices like the Android native Motorola Defy 2.2.2 Froyo, only support pixel ratio 2.0 (see below) so that was our only choice.




2 fixes

Fixed Android Gmail app issue, whereby it was drawing the SVG outline and text along with PNG:



Adjusted 500px cut off to 600px, as the original Kindle Fire 7" tablet - Silk (based on Android vr2), was failing to load the SVG (see below). Now loads PNG, res is 600 x 1024 btw.



Though this means some mid-range tablets like the 7" Kindle Fire HD, now get the PNG when they previously supported the SVG at 500px.


